Enhancements

Public Profile Improvements

We've enhanced the public personnel profile experience to give site supervisors and compliance officers more useful information when scanning worker QR codes in the field, whilst maintaining appropriate privacy controls.

Limited Profile Display for Non-Consented Personnel

Previously, when supervisors scanned the QR code of personnel who hadn't completed their full registration, they would encounter an error message with no useful information. This created friction at site access points and made it difficult to assess work eligibility.

Now supervisors can view all public profiles to access essential information to make informed decisions:

- Worker's first name and last name initial
- Classification
- QR code
- Confirmed role information

This balanced approach ensures supervisors have the information they need to assess work eligibility whilst respecting personnel privacy preferences during the registration process.

Upcoming Expiration Warnings

The public profile now displays amber warning indicators when attainments are expiring within the next 30 days. This brings the public profile in line with the rest of the MyPass system's visual language and helps supervisors proactively identify personnel who need to renew certifications or training before they expire.

Previously, the system only showed green ticks for compliant attainments and red crosses for expired ones, which meant supervisors had no advance warning of upcoming expirations. This enhancement helps prevent last-minute compliance issues that could delay work schedules.

Documents Open in a New Tab

When reviewing personnel compliance in the role view screen, you can now open multiple documents simultaneously for comparison. The "View Document" button now opens each document in a new browser tab, allowing accreditation officers to check data points across multiple documents efficiently.

This addresses feedback from accreditation officers at client sites who needed to cross-reference information between documents to verify work eligibility. Previously, documents opened in the same tab, requiring officers to navigate back and forth between views.

General Performance and Stability Improvements

We've made some general technical updates in the background to improve performance and stability.

Compliance % in Personnel Compliance Exports

The Compliance % was displayed as 0% in the Personnel Compliance exports (full report and simplified version). This is now fixed and Compliance % calculations are accurate.
