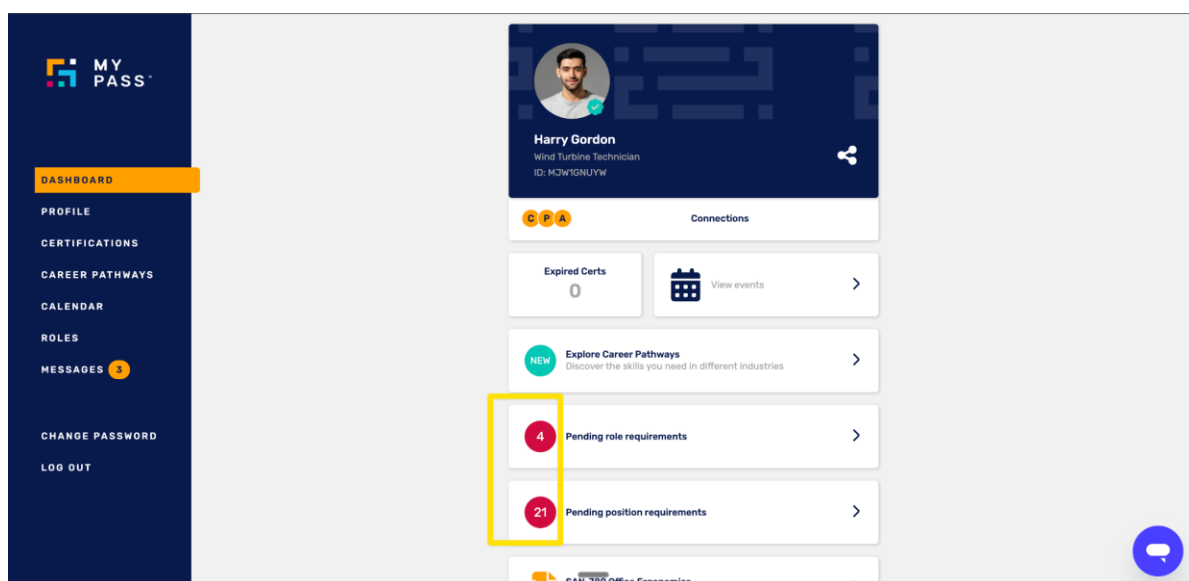
## Enhancements

### Digital Skills Passport Pending Requirement Counts

On the web version of the digital skills passport, the 'Pending role requirements' and 'Pending position requirements' now more accurately reflect the number of pending requirements.

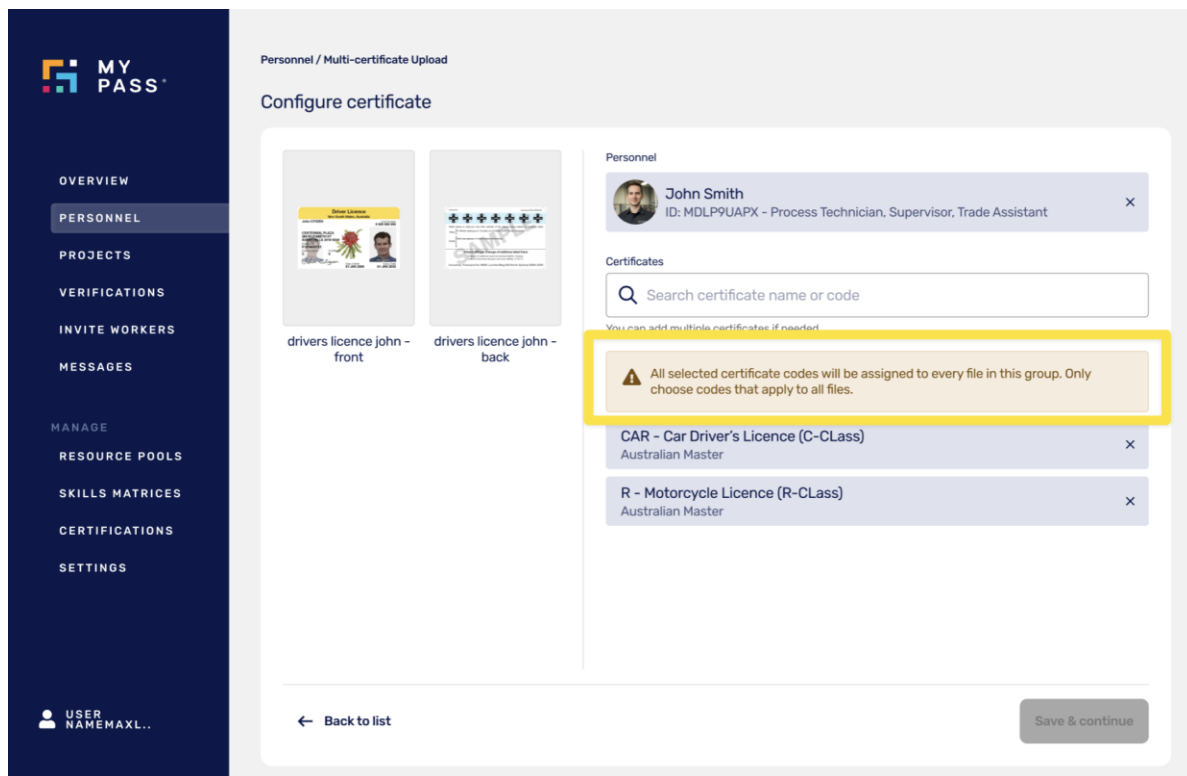
Where a certificate group uses "any" logic (the personnel needs any one of several certificates), the count now shows at the parent level rather than inflating the total with every individual option.

This change gives personnel a more accurate picture of how many outstanding requirements truly need attention.



### Multi-Certificate Upload Document Group Notice

Within the Multi-Certificate Upload workflow, when configuring a group of documents and selecting more than one certificate code, a new informational notice is now displayed. This helps users understand the implications of applying multiple certificate codes to groups of documents.



## Overview > Project Export Logic

We modified the logic in Overview > Project exports. Previously, for engagements that had passed their end dates, the end date was used as the cut-off for calculating certificate status, meaning that certificates that expired after the engagement end date were showing as "Expiring Soon" instead of "Expired". This logic now determines certificate status as per the date the report is run as opposed to relative to the engagement end date.

## Fixes

### Duplicate Engagements Following Profile Merge

Resolved an issue that was causing duplicate engagements to be created for personnel after duplicate profiles were merged. This fix addresses the root cause, preventing future occurrences and eliminating the need for manual corrections.

### Pending Verifications Tab

Resolved an issue in the Industry Portal where the Pending verifications tab was displaying certificates that had already been approved or rejected. While this was a visual-only issue with no impact on actual compliance status, it caused confusion for administrators and has now been corrected to show only genuinely pending items.

### Clearing Identity Fields

Resolved an issue where workers were unable to delete a value from the Passport Number or RUT fields in their worker profile. While it was possible to update these fields, clearing them entirely was not — leaving no way to correct a mistake like entering a passport number in the RUT field. Workers can now clear either field freely, as long as at least one of the two remains filled. This ensures identity data stays accurate without locking workers into incorrect entries.
