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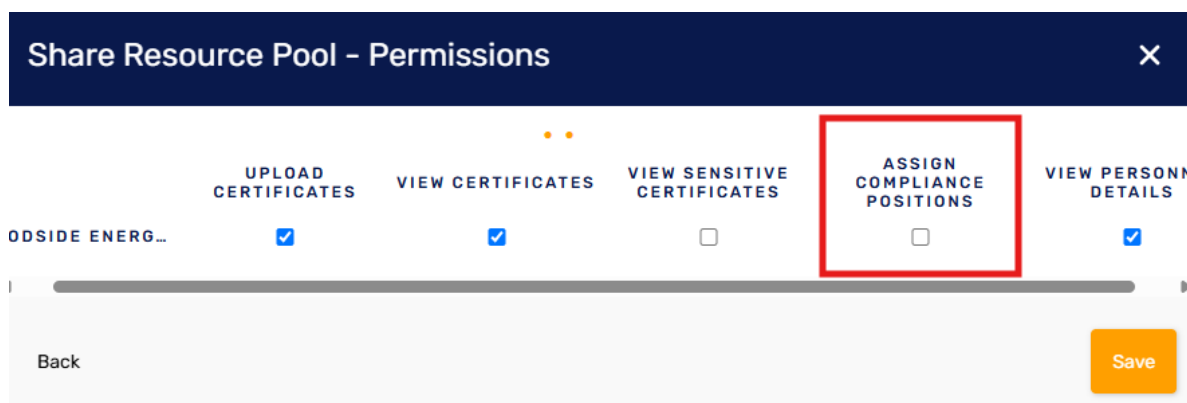

Compliance Position Assignment Governance

Service providers now have explicit control over whether an owner client can assign compliance positions to personnel in a shared Resource Pool.

Previously, once a Resource Pool was shared, there was no dedicated way to control who could assign compliance positions to that personnel.

A new "Assign Compliance Positions" permission is available on the Resource Pool sharing screen. When a service provider shares a pool, they choose whether to switch this permission on or off — it starts switched off by default, so it's always an active decision. This choice can be changed at any time by editing the share, including turning access off after it's been granted.

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Where a service provider has enabled the permission, owner clients can then assign it to the relevant user groups within their own organisation, giving their team the ability to assign compliance positions to shared personnel.

Compliance positions can only be assigned from Skills Matrices the service provider has associated with the pool, so both parties retain full visibility over what's in scope. Existing sharing permissions, such as viewing certificates and personnel details, are unaffected.
